# Reconciliation

**<sup>19</sup> that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message**

**<sup>20</sup> We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: **Be reconciled to God.****

**<sup>21</sup> God made him who had no sin to be sin<sup>[b]</sup> for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.**

## **Romans 5:11**


Not only is this so, but we also boast in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received **reconciliation**



first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye


